Who's Who in Language Services and Technology: 2017 Rankings	18 29	Appen (#17 on our 2017 global list) is incorrectly listed as having 12 employees.	As of year-end 2016, it had 180 employees. This was a transcription error.
Who's Who in Language Services and Technology: 2017 Rankings	19 22	Due to an error in survey input and/or a subsequent communications error, Sunyu in China (#40 on the 2016 global list and #6 on the 2016 Asian list) was omitted from the ranking process.	Sunyu would have been #42 on the 2017 global list and #7 on the 2017 Asian list with reported revenue equating to US\$25.20 million.
Who's Who in Language Services and Technology: 2017 Rankings	20 26	Due to an error in survey input and/or a subsequent communications error, ITL Institut für technische Literatur in Germany (#54 on the 2016 global list and #13 on the 2016 Western European list) was omitted from the ranking process. Who's Who in Language Services and Technology: 2017 Rankings	35 40	On page 35, Sandberg Translation Partners (#72 on our 2016 global list) is incorrectly listed as having earned US\$9.83 million in revenue, an increase of 0.41% over its 2015 turnover.	Sandberg Translation Partners earned GBP 7.82 million in revenue. This meant that it grew 13.28% over the preceding year. The table on page 40 correctly lists the currency and growth.
Who's Who in Language Services and Technology: 2017 Rankings	39	The list of largest LSPs in Eastern Europe is missing Skrivanek Holding SE (#41 on our 2016 global list and #2 on the 2016 Eastern European list).	Skrivanek would have been #2 on the CSA Research 2017 Eastern European list. This error does not affect Skrivanek's #42 ranking in the top 100.
The Language Services Market: 2017	5	The 2017 and subsequent market sizing for Oceania did not include Appen (#17 on our 2017 global list), resulting in an under-representation of the region.	No adjustments to the regional market sizing were made.
